

JOURNEYPERSON UPGRADE TRAINING CONTINUAL EDUCATION FAQS

- Q Who needs Journeyperson upgrade training?
- A Journeyperson upgrade training is required per the CBA for all 469 building trades active Journeypersons.
- Q How many training hours do I need?
- A 2025 Requirement: You need 8 hours of continual education for the year 2025/26. 2024 Requirement: You need 8 hours of continual education for the year 2024/25.
- Q What date do I need to have my training hours done by?
- A 2025 Requirement: Must be completed by 5-31-26 to receive your raise on 7-01-26. 2024 Requirement: Training was due by 5-31-25 to receive your raise on 7-01-25.
- Q I took more than 8 hours. Do the extra hours roll over to the next year?
- A Yes. 50% of your extra hours will transfer to the following year, up to a max of 8 hours.
 - **Example 1:** If you took a 32-hour training class, 8 hours will transfer to the following year. **Example 2:** If you took 10 hours of training, 5 hours (50%) will transfer to the following year.
- Q Where do I sign up for training?
- A All training classes will be available in the new 469 Training portal (<u>469training.com</u>), which you can access on your desktop or via the Go.Learn mobile app.

- Q How do I check how many training hours I have completed?
- A You can check your training hours at <u>469training.com</u>.
- Q How long does it take for my certificate or training hours to show up in my profile?
- A It can take up to 10 business days for your training hours or certificate to appear in your profile. If you do not see it after that time, please email PIPE at info@pipetrust.org.

- Q I am a traveler, am I required to take this continual education?
- A No, not for the 2025-26 year.
- Q I am a Local 469 member and travel, am I required to do continual education?
- A Members working outside of Local 469 jurisdiction and returning to Local 469 jurisdiction on or after July 1st will have a ninety (90) day period to complete their hours.

Members working outside of Local 469 jurisdiction for 6 months and 1 day or more within a contract year (July 1 – June 30) will be exempt from continual education training for that contract year only.

- Q I received external training relevant to the trades. Does that count?
- A You need to submit the training information for approval to receive credit for these training hours. You can do this on <u>469training.com</u> in the Log External Training link.
- Q I was late completing my annual training requirement. What happens now?

You will NOT receive your raise on July 1 for that year.

If you finish after May 31, your raise will be delayed by one full month. It will then take effect on the first day of the following month.

Example: If you complete training on September 12, your one-month delay ends on October 12. Your raise will then begin on November 1.
